This aspect makes PediSafe a reliable choice for ongoing toenail care and maintenance.

PediSafe can be used for clients who have no existing toenail. Tailor made to fit your customer, the prosthetic nail can be removed and reapplied as needed.

- Exposure of UV lamp to the skin on a semi regular basis for 4-6 minutes is very low risk for UV damage when performed every 6-8 weeks.
- To be platinum sun/UV safe standard SW Podiatry & Health Clinic advise you apply a factor 50+ sun cream to your feet 30 minutes prior to your appointment.
- Avoid tight or high heeled shoes.
- Avoid prolonged bathing, saunas and hot tubs.
- PediSafe is not suitable for intense sporting activities such as running – for those who are highly active, in this case PediSafe nail reconstruction should only be worn for special occasions.
- Your nail reconstruction should last between 2-8 weeks, but this depends on your level of activity and not getting the nails too wet.
- Your nail reconstruction can be cut like normal nail, but it is recommended that your podiatrist cuts your nails for you.
- It is advised that your nails are completely dry for 12 hours prior to your treatment to avoid moisture being trapped under the nail, which could lead to pseudomonas.
